Building 1: Worship and Priest Housing

- **Worship Area:** A serene space dedicated to spiritual practices and community gatherings.
- **Priest Housing:** Comfortable living quarters for our esteemed priests.

Building 2: Multifunctional Auditorium

- **Congregation Hall:** Seating capacity of at least 1000, suitable for large gatherings and events.
- **Kitchen:** Fully equipped for all catering needs.
- **Multi-Purpose Area:** Versatile spaces for cafeteria, community hall, classrooms, conferences, and children's activities.

Senior Housing: Located at the rear land, offering a peaceful environment for our senior community members.

Dedicated Land for Other Faiths: Space allocated for other religious communities to build their own places of worship.

Amphitheater: Open-air venue for performances, lectures, and community events.
